

RULE OF THE MONTH with Tom & Chip



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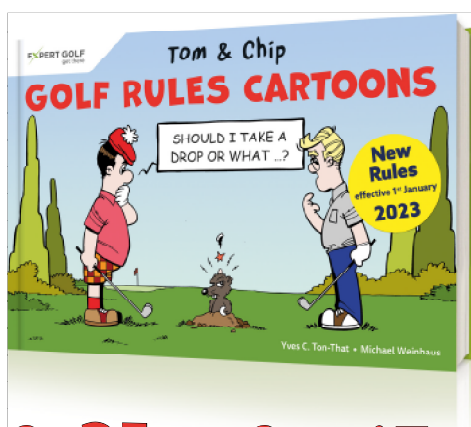
SITUATION: Tom brings some clubs that he wants to test ...



QUESTION: What's the maximum number of clubs allowed, and what's the penalty for carrying too many?

ANSWER: The rules allow a maximum of 14 clubs. If a player begins their round with more than this, they must declare the extra clubs out of play once they become aware of the breach. In stroke play, they'll be penalized 2 strokes per hole, with a maximum of 4 strokes per round. Rule 4.1b.

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
