

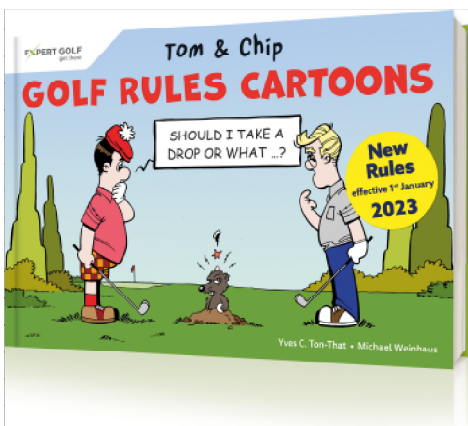
SITUATION: Tom's ball has a bad lie under the lip of a bunker ...



QUESTION: May Tom drop his ball outside the bunker when taking unplayable ball relief back on the line?

ANSWER: Yes. There are four dropping options when declaring a ball unplayable in a bunker. Dropping back on the line is possible inside as well as outside of the bunker. If the ball is dropped inside the bunker, the penalty is 1 stroke whereas if dropped outside of the bunker, the penalty is 2 strokes. Rule 19.3.
