

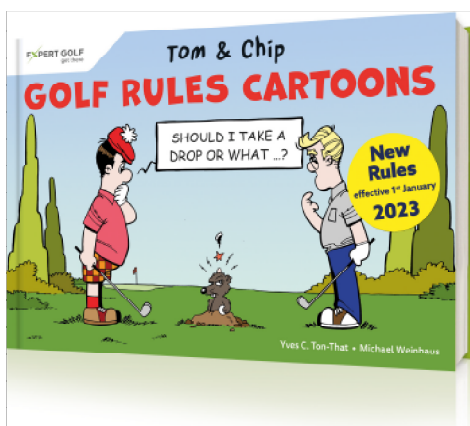
SITUATION: After a bad tee shot, Tom plays a provisional ball ...



QUESTION: Is Tom allowed to continue play with one of the balls, or are they both considered lost?

ANSWER: If a ball can't be identified, it's usually considered lost. However, in this special case both balls belong to the same player. Therefore, Tom must choose one of the balls and treat it as his provisional ball, i.e., it becomes the ball in play with 1 penalty stroke. Tom will be hitting his 4th shot. Rule 18.3c(2).
