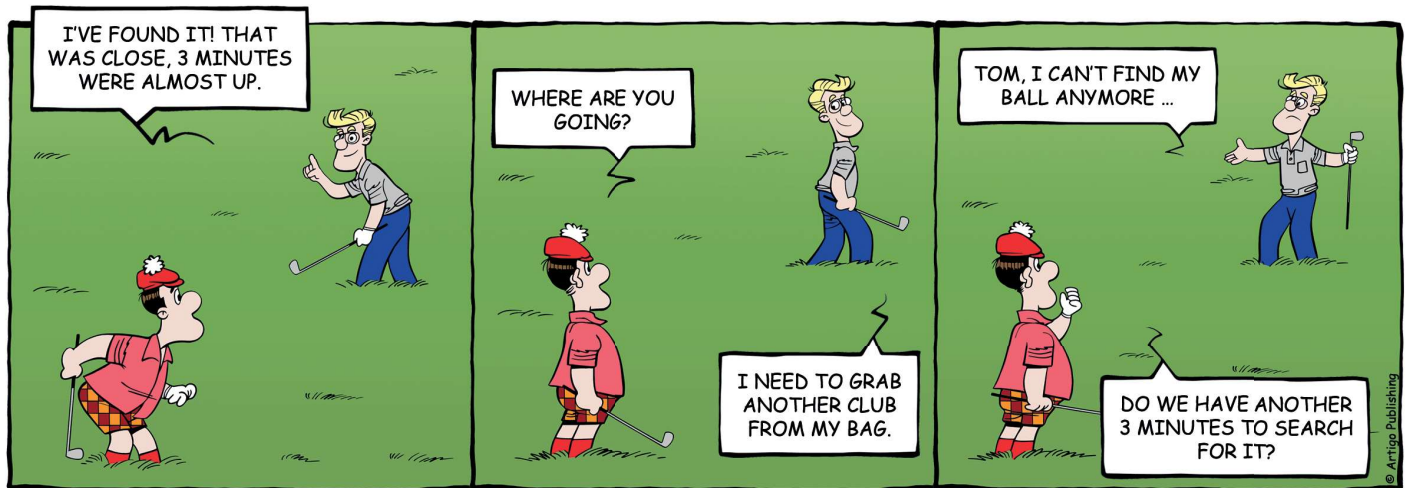


SITUATION: Chip's ball has landed in the rough where it's hard to find ...



QUESTION: If Chip finds his ball after 2 ½ minutes and then loses sight of it, how much search time does he then have to find it again?

ANSWER: A player is allowed a total of 3 minutes to find their ball. If a ball is found and then lost as in the above scenario, the clock stops when the ball is found but it doesn't start over when the ball is lost again. Chip has 30 seconds left to find his ball before it's considered lost. Rule 18.2a(1) and clarification 18.2a(1)/1.
