SITUATION: Tom's ball is wedged between the lip of the hole and the flagstick ...



QUESTION: **When's a ball considered holed?**

ANSWER: When a ball's resting against the flagstick in the hole, if any part of the ball is below the surface of the green, the ball is considered holed. Tom's ball is holed, it's not necessary for all of it to be below the surface of the green. Rule 13.2c.
